NOTICE OF ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Special Municipal Election consolidated with the Statewide Direct Primary Election will be held in the City of Oakdale, County of Stanislaus, State of California, on the 7th of June, 2022, for the following office:

One (1) Council Member for the remainder of a term to end December 2024.

Qualifications for Office:

- Must be an elector of the city and a registered voter of the city at the time nomination papers are issued to the candidate (EC §10227, GC §36502).
- Must be 18 years old and a citizen of the state at the time of election or appointment (GC §1020).
- Must have a domicile within the City of Oakdale (EC §349).
- Must not have been convicted of a felony involving accepting or giving, or offering to give, any bribe, the embezzlement of public money, extortion or theft of public money, perjury, or conspiracy to commit any of those crimes (EC §20).

If no one or only one person is nominated for an elective office, appointment to the elective office may be made as prescribed by §10229, Elections Code of the State of California.

The nomination period for these offices begins on February 14, 2022 at 8:00 a.m. and closes on March 11, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. Declaration of Candidacy forms are available at the office of the City Clerk located at 280 North Third Avenue, Oakdale, California. The Declaration of Candidacy form is to be filed at the office of the City Clerk before the close of the nomination period, §12101, 12111, Elections Code of the State of California.

The candidate is to pay for the publication of a Candidate's Statement of Qualifications pursuant to §13307 Elections Code of the State of California.

Per The Voter's Choice Act, a ballot will be mailed to all active registered voters 29 days before Election Day. A list of vote centers and ballot drop boxes will be posted on the City of Oakdale website, www.oakdalegov.com/election and on the Stanislaus County Registrar of Voters website at <https://www.stanvote.com/pdf/vote-center-drop-boxes-generic.pdf> approximately 29 days prior to the Election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that ballots from the June 7, 2022 are to be tallied and the canvass of the vote will be conducted at the Stanislaus County Elections Division (central counting place) at 1021 "I" Street, Suite 101, Modesto, California commencing June 9, 2022 through July 7, 2022. All proceedings at the central counting place are open to the public pursuant to §15204, Elections Code of the State of California.
