Oakdale Police Arrest Suspect Responsible for Vandalism and Graffiti

Oakdale, CA – On 9/19/2021 at approximately 8:30 a.m., Oakdale Police arrested 41-year-old Jarod Russell Anthony Silva at his home in Oakdale. Silva had a Ramey Warrant out for his arrest and was taken into custody by officers without incident and booked into county jail charged with vandalism.

It is believed that Silva is responsible for numerous graffiti cases throughout town over the past several weeks. Most recently, seven graffiti incidents were reported last week using the same graffiti tag. Locations of the vandalism included several downtown businesses, a bus stop, Oakdale High School, and the Community Skate Park.
