## Qualifications for Office:

- Must be an elector of the city and a registered voter of the city at the time nomination papers are issued to the candidate (EC §10227, GC §36502).
- Must be 18 years old and a citizen of the state at the time of election or appointment (GC §1020).
- Must have a domicile within the City of Oakdale (EC §349).
- Must not have been convicted of a felony involving accepting or giving, or offering to give, any bribe, the embezzlement of public money, extortion or theft of public money, perjury, or conspiracy to commit any of those crimes (EC §20).

If no one or only one person is nominated for an elective office, appointment to the elective office may be made as prescribed by §10229, Elections Code of the State of California.

The nomination period for these offices begins on July 13, 2020 and closes on August 7, 2020, at 5:00 p.m. Declaration of candidacy forms are available at the office of the City Clerk located at 280 North Third Avenue, Oakdale, California. The declaration of candidacy form is to be filed at the office of the City Clerk before the close of the nomination period. §12101, 12111, Elections Code of the State of California.

If nomination papers for an incumbent officer of the city are not filed by August 7, 2020, (the 88th day before the election, the voters shall have until the 83rd day before the election, August 12, 2020, to nominate candidates other than the person(s) who are the incumbents on the 88th day before the election, for that incumbent's elective office. This extension is not applicable where there is no incumbent eligible to be elected.

The candidate is to pay for the publication of a Candidate's Statement of Qualifications pursuant to §13307 Elections Code of the State of California.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that in accordance with Executive Order N-64-20, issued by California Governor Gavin Newsom on May 8, 2020, which states that all Californians who are registered (and otherwise eligible) to vote in the November 3, 2020 General Election shall receive vote-by-mail ballots, and Executive Order N-67-20, issued on June 3, 2020, which outlines the requirements for in-person voting sites for the 2020 General Election in November, ballot drop off locations will be open from Saturday, October 31, 2020 through Monday, November 2, 2020, for 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that ballots from the November 3, 2020 Presidential General Election are to be tallied and the canvass of the vote will be conducted at the Stanislaus County Elections Division (central counting place) at 1021 "I" Street, Suite 101, Modesto, California commencing no later than 9:00 a.m. November 5, 2020. All proceedings at the central counting place are open to the public pursuant to §15204, Elections Code of the State of California.
