Oakdale Police Sergeant Will Undergo Surgery After Being Struck by a Vehicle

Oakdale, CA – An Oakdale police sergeant is being treated at a local hospital after being struck by a vehicle while conducting a DUI investigation. The 22-year veteran of the Oakdale PD suffered a broken leg and will undergo surgery today. He is in stable condition and expected to make a full recovery. Just after 8:00 last night, officers responded to a 9-1-1 call reporting a traffic collision involving two vehicles in the 1300 block of West F Street. Officers and fire personnel arrived on scene to investigate the traffic collision. During that investigation, the sergeant was struck by a vehicle heading eastbound. Oakdale Police personnel are assisting CHP with the investigation. It does not appear that alcohol or drugs are a factor in this collision. No charges will be filed against the driver who struck the sergeant.
