

June 7, 2022 Special Municipal Election

The City of Oakdale City Council is comprised of five Councilmembers, elected at-large for four-year terms. A Special Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, June 7, 2022, for the election of one City Councilmember to complete a term ending in 2024.

To be eligible to run for City Council, candidates must reside within the city of Oakdale incorporated boundaries and:

- Must be an elector of the city and a registered voter of the city at the time nomination papers are issued. (EC §10227, GC §36502)
- Must be 18 years old and a citizen of the state at the time of election or appointment. (GC §1020)
- Must have a domicile within the City of Oakdale. (EC §349)
- Must file a Declaration of Candidacy or statement of write-in candidacy with the Elections Official. (EC §13)
- Must not have been convicted of a felony involving accepting or giving, or offering to give, any bribe, the embezzlement of public money, extortion or theft of public money, perjury, or conspiracy to commit any of those crimes. (EC §20)

Interested residents must make an appointment with the City Clerk's Office to receive and submit campaign documents during the Nomination Period. The Nomination Period begins Monday, February 14, 2022 at 8:00 a.m. and ends on Friday, March 11, 2022 at 5:00 p.m.

Step 1: Contact the City Clerk for an appointment

The City Clerk's Office will begin taking appointments for the Nomination Period (February 14 – March 11) beginning Monday, February 7, 2022. The appointment will take approximately 45 minutes. Call the City Clerk's Office at 209-845-3573 to schedule an appointment.

Step 2: Complete nomination papers and collect signatures

February 14, 2022 – March 11, 2022

Step 3: File nomination papers with the City Clerk

Deadline March 11, 2022 by 5:00 p.m.
